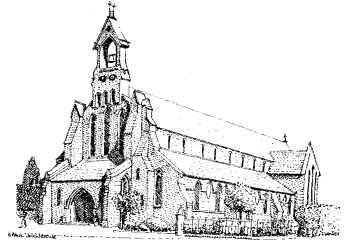

### Youth Walking Pilgrimage to the Grotto (4th - 6th Sept)

As part of the pilgrimage to the Grotto, a group of young people will walk over a period of two days through the Lake District, and will join pilgrims from all over the diocese here at the shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes for Mass with Bishop Brian Noble on Sunday 6th September at 3pm. Passing through stunning landscapes, the Big Walk is an unforgettable experience, and one in which young people from across the diocese get to meet up with each other, enjoy each other's company and develop new friendships. Their bags are ferried from place to place and all food is provided.

We are looking for young people who are 16 years and over who would be interested in joining the group.

The group will spend the first night, Friday 4th September, at Castlerigg (arrivals from 7pm, no evening meal though there will be sandwiches and crisps available in the evening), and then walk from Honister across Haystacks into Ennerdale, spending the night there in a fantastic hostel with amazing food and open fires. The walk concludes with the diocesan Mass at Cleator at 3pm on Sunday. The walk is about 10 miles each day.
