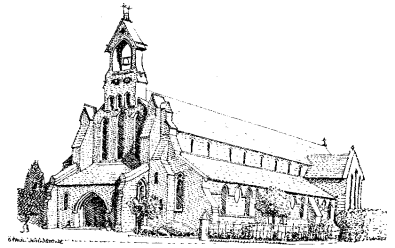

- * **Rice Pudding** (Tinned)
- * **Cereal** (Medium 500g ONLY)
- * **Pasta Sauces** (jars or sachets)
- * **Sugar** (small and large bags)
- * **Pasta** (Medium bags of dried pasta. NO sachets of 'pasta & sauce' mixes)
- * **Milk** (Full Fat or Semi- Skimmed UHT)
- * **Sponge Pudding** (Tinned)
- * **Biscuits or snack bars**
- * **Tea Bags/Instant Coffee** (Medium or small)
