PARISH WALK - SATURDAY OCTOBER 6TH AT 1PM

Hello everyone.....at last here are the details of our Sponsored Heritage Trail. This particular walk is one we have done before (7th June 2003!!!! Time flies!) but is well worth repeating.

The trail begins in the Car Park of St. Bega's Hall, Bowthorn, which accesses the Cycle Path to Moor Row. The walk will take about one and a half hours and there will be stops at particular places of interest on the way. Information will be given at these points (see map). We will pass by the Crossfield, Moor Row and Montreal pits. There were approximately 120 pits in an area of 10 sq. miles. Most of them were worked for about ten years and were abandoned. We will see such delights as The Black Ship, The Dog Tunnel and The Cock Ring. We then continue along the Cycle Path to the Cleator Cricket Field. Then on to main Street Cleator, along Jacktrees Road and on to McKenzies Lonning (if accessible) where we rejoin the Cycle Path. We hope you will be able to absorb the wonderful sense of History, and the now beautiful views from this Trail. The scarred landscape of yesterday has all but healed and little remains of the mining era for which Cleator Moor was famous.

The walk ends back at St. Bega's Hall, where one of our Priests will give a Blessing to the walkers. The highlight of the walk will be the refreshments in the Hall.....tea, coffee and CUPCAKES !! And time to catch up on all the crack.....

Please come along...bring the kids and the dogs. Wheelchair access is easy and wheelchair users will be warmly welcomed.
