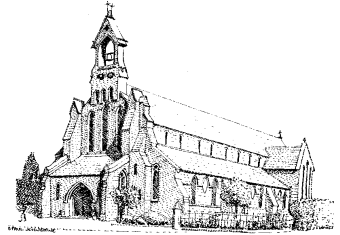

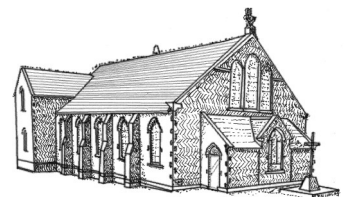

The Caritas Group have organised a fundraising appeal for Sight Savers who work in more than 30 countries to eliminate avoidable blindness.

The appeal commences on **Sunday 24th July to Sunday 21st August.**

Sight Savers work to prevent and treat avoidable blindness. Trachoma a painful eye infection that is the world's leading cause of preventable blindness, and occurs where people live in overcrowded conditions with limited access to clean water and health care, it spreads easy from child to child. Antibiotic treatment that can stop this painful condition and save sight costs less than £1.

80% of blindness in the world is avoidable, that sounds unfair.

The Foodbank is designed to help individuals and families in crisis, through the provision of emergency food supplies. Local professional care-workers within Allerdale and Copeland refer them, with a food voucher, to the Foodbank centre where they are given their food supplies, a cup of coffee and help in finding other professionals who can help them out of their crisis.

Over the 6 weeks of the summer holidays the Foodbank are running a scheme called **Holiday Lunchpaks 4 Kids.**

During the holidays there is extra financial pressure on families to provide meals which are given at school.
