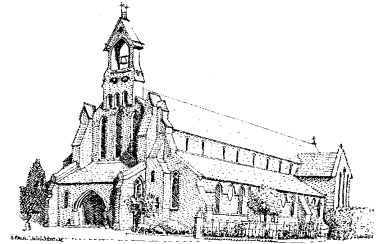

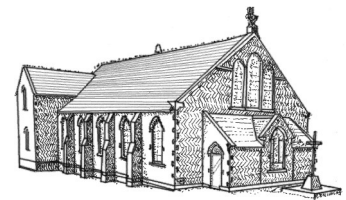

PETITION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR HEALTH

Under the Abortion Act 1967, nearly 4,000 babies are aborted every week in Britain. Most abortions are authorised because it's claimed the pregnancy is a risk to the mother's mental health, but the latest medical evidence confirms that abortion does not lead to better mental health for women. The law is clearly abused. Now the Department of Health, instead of enforcing the law, is seeking to widen abortion services even further.

We call on the Secretary of State for Health to ensure that doctors do not misinform and mislead women by authorising abortion on invalid mental health grounds.
