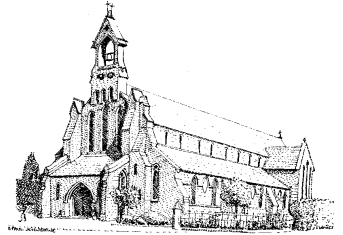

### **Holiday Lunchpacks for Kids Scheme**

Many families experience increased demand on their resources during the holiday period, as during term time they may have been in receipt of free school meals. Over the 6 week summer holiday around 150 families will receive a pack that contains lunches for up to 3 children x 5 days.

157 packs per week have to be made up, so many volunteers are needed.
