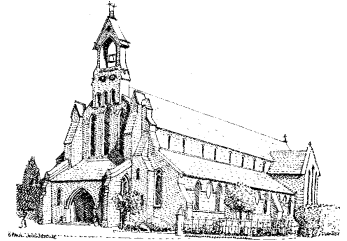

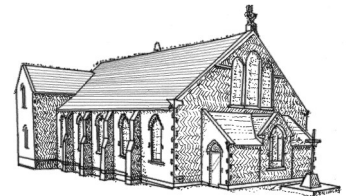

The Foodbank is designed to help individuals and families in crisis, through the provision of emergency food supplies. Local professional care-workers within Allerdale and Copeland refer them, with a food voucher, to the Foodbank centre where they are given their food supplies, a cup of coffee and help in finding other professionals who can help them out of their crisis.

Over the 7 weeks of the summer holidays the Foodbank are running a scheme called **Holiday Lunchpaks 4 Kids.**

During the holidays there is extra financial pressure on families to provide meals which are given at school. They will be helping around 240 families in Allerdale and Copeland.

Families who have a low income will be given a weekly pack which contains lunches for the 5 weekdays. 13 tonnes of food is needed to feed up to 600 children per week for the 7 weeks of the school holidays.
