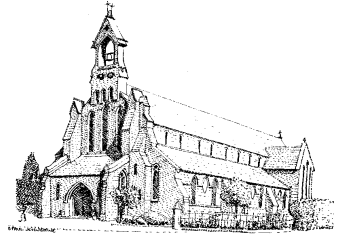

### **SIGHT SAVERS INTERNATIONAL**

The Caritas Group have organised a fundraising appeal for Sight Savers who work in more than 30 countries to eliminate avoidable blindness.

The appeal closes on **Sunday 21st August**.

Sight Savers work to prevent and treat avoidable blindness. Trachoma a painful eye infection that is the world's leading cause of preventable blindness, and occurs where people live in overcrowded conditions with limited access to clean water and health care, it spreads easy from child to child. Antibiotic treatment that can stop this painful condition and save sight costs less than £1.

80% of blindness in the world is avoidable, that sounds unfair.

### **MARY'S MEALS**

Mary's Meals would like to express their heartfelt thanks for the recent donation of £626 from our parish. They are very grateful for your support. Every donation to Mary's Meals, large or small, goes a long way to helping to provide more children with a nutritious daily meal in their place of education.



The Foodbank is designed to help individuals and families in crisis, through the provision of emergency food supplies. Local professional care-workers within Allerdale and Copeland refer them, with a food voucher, to the Foodbank centre where they are given their food supplies, a cup of coffee and help in finding other professionals who can help them out of their crisis.

Over the 6 weeks of the summer holidays the Foodbank are running a scheme called **Holiday Lunchpacks 4 Kids**.

During the holidays there is extra financial pressure on families to provide meals which are given at school.

Families who have a low income will be given a weekly pack which contains lunches for the 5 weekdays.
